

INSTRUCTIONS



- 1 Package all mobile phones, their batteries and accessories* in a sturdy cardboard box or padded satchel. Remove all personal information from your mobile/s and SIM card before placing in the box/padded satchel. Any data left on the device will be destroyed in the recycling process.
- 2 Keep the battery of mobile phones within the handset.
- 3 If you are recycling any loose mobile phone batteries without a handset, wrap the battery in bubble wrap or similar and seal before putting in the box. Each battery must be completely enclosed in inner packaging so it does not come into contact with other items in the box.
- 4 Seal the parcel and affix this label to the outside.
- 5 Read and sign the Senders Declaration.
- 6 Drop it off at an Australia Post outlet or place in a red street post box for free anywhere within Australia**

* This package must only include mobile phones, their batteries, chargers and accessories and/or wireless USB broadband devices. Please visit recyclingnearyou.com.au to find recycling options for other e-waste items.

** Some remote locations in Australia can only be reached by air. If you are based in such a location, Australia Post cannot guarantee that your package will reach its destination, as lithium batteries are not accepted by air carriers in the mail. In such an instance, the package will be returned to sender.

SENDERS PACKAGING AND DANGEROUS GOODS DECLARATION

I, the sender, declare that:

1. All handsets or loose batteries have been packaged in accordance with the instructions above.
2. All mobile phone accessories (charger etc.) have been separated from the handset(s) and packed appropriately.
3. All batteries are either still connected to the mobile phone or completely wrapped individually.
4. The sender acknowledges that the package contains dangerous goods (Lithium battery) and the sender declares that the articles contained in the package have been packed in accordance with the current Australian Code for the Transport of Dangerous Goods by Road and Rail.
5. The parcel does not contain any other dangerous or prohibited goods (apart from those specified above), e.g. explosives, flammables, corrosives, aerosols, etc.
