WHAT IS THE SUPPLIER CODE OF CONDUCT?

Telstra views its suppliers as partners and cares about the way our suppliers do business.

Telstra's Supplier Code of Conduct (Code) sets out the minimum standards of behaviour that Telstra expects its suppliers to meet.

WHO DOES THE SUPPLIER CODE OF CONDUCT APPLY TO?

The Code applies to any entity that supplies goods or services to Telstra Corporation Ltd or its related companies anywhere in the world.

WHAT DOES THE UPDATED CODE COVER?

The updated Code includes the following standards:

- Labour and human rights
- Health and safety
- Environmental considerations
- Business integrity
- Privacy; and
- Diversity

WHAT HAS CHANGED IN THE UPDATED CODE?

This updated Code contains new requirements in relation to human rights, protection of intellectual property, fair competition and trade controls. In addition, to ensure we continually improve how we work with our suppliers, we have made this updated Code simpler, clearer and shorter.

WHEN DOES THE UPDATED CODE BECOME EFFECTIVE?

28 February 2018.

WHAT IS EXPECTED OF SUPPLIERS?

Supplier should familiarise themselves with the updated Code and take action to confirm that they are complying.
