




#### Three ways to call





## Skype – on the phone or tablet



#### Three ways to call

- 1. Call non-contacts
  Click the Meet Now button to start a video call with people not in your contact list
- 2. Call one contact
  Click the phone or video
  button to call one person in
  your contact list
- 3. Call multiple contacts
  Click the phone plus button
  to select multiple contacts
  and call them


## Skype — on the phone or tablet

Take control




Click the End call button to hang up










## The 5 S's of video call set up


